

### 1 Downloading the app

1.1 Download the Nokia WiFi app on either Android (Google Playstore) or iPhone (Apple Store)



#### **2 Connect Your Router**

- 2.1 Power up the router with the power adapter provided.
- 2.2 Connect the **WAN port** to the **LAN 1/UNID1 port** of the Fiber Box (i.e., Opticomm box) using the **Ethernet cable**.

#### 3 Setup Your Router

- Scan the QR code
  Using your phone's camera, scan the QR code on the bottom of your root Wi-Fi point.
- 3.1 Using a thin object such as a paper clip or pen, press on the Reset button located on the back of the router and hold for at least 10 seconds or until the light on the front flashes red.
- 3.2 Open your Nokia WiFi app and select **Get Started**. Then scan the QR code located on the bottom of your Nokia Beacon 1.1.



3.3 You should have your router connected at this point, so you can select **My network is set up**.



- 3.4 You must be connected to your Nokia WiFi network to use the app. Please check the WiFi settings on your phone to make sure you are connected.
- \*NOTE The router light must be green-blue for you to be able to connect to the WiFi. You may have to wait a few minutes for the router to finish booting up before you can even find the WiFi network on your phone and connect.
- 3.5 Once you are connected, proceed in the app. Now just wait a few minutes for the WiFi to be set up.




#### 4 WiFi configuration page

- 4.1 Once your WiFi has finished setting up, you should be taken to the main page.
- 4.2 In the bottom right of your screen, select **Settings > Network > Networking Mode**.



4.3 Change the **Networking Mode** to **PPPoE** and Enter the PPPOE username and password we sent to you in your service activation email. Save via the check mark in the top right.



## 5 Optional: Change your WiFi name and password/PIN

Simply click on your WiFi network within the app and change the WiFi name and password there.
